SOCIO-ECONOMIC AND CASTE CENSUS – CIRCULAR No. 7

Subject: Incorporation of New location codes for updating jurisdictional changes between Census 2011 and SECC- regarding.

As you are aware, NPR images of selected fields were used in the SECC field-work. For merging of digitized NPR data for these images, the instructions have already been issued through SECC Circular No.s 5 and 6 and the exercise has already been started by many States/UTs.

2. **A summary of the progress of merging digitized NPR data in SECC is given at Annex 1 of this Circular.** The detailed report for each State/district, separately for the Rural and Urban areas is available in the SECC monitoring site maintained by the NIC. The DP Division has also circulated the list of mismatched EBs between the finalized list of EBs used for generating the PCA and the SECC. You should go through the report at the NIC and the list sent by the DP Division to expeditiously reconcile the mismatches in EB codes, so that the matching of person records are not hindered due to lack of matching of the EBs between the NPR and the SECC.

3. From some of the States/UTs, references have been received regarding changes in jurisdiction due to notifications from the respective State/UT Governments 31st December 2009. During the field-work of the SECC, changes in the location codes of the EBs, whose jurisdiction has changed after Census 2011, were not done. The purpose was not only to have a smoother field-work where the AHL and Charge Registers from the Census were being used in SECC, but also to have a smoother data merging. However, as the rural and urban questionnaires of the SECC were different, canvassing of the questionnaire has been done as per the latest jurisdiction.

4. However, in the finalized data of the SECC, these changed jurisdictions need to be reflected, as the draft list of the SECC would be published as per the latest jurisdictions. In order to achieve this, the changes after the Census need to be compiled in a comprehensive manner at the EB level. Some of the States have already made such a list and sent it to the ORGI hqrs., so that the DP Division can generate the location codes for these as per the MDDS guidelines.

5. Keeping in view the requirement of the SECC, all of you may compile such a list of jurisdictional changes between the Census and SECC and send the list to the DP Division for generation of these codes and further action at their end. **The format for sending this information to the DPD Hqrs. is given at Annexure 2 of this Circular.**
