

Case

Bhatri nouns are inflected for six cases, viz.. i) nominative, ii) accusative/dative, iii) instrumental, iv) ablative, v) genitive and vi) locative.

The markers for these different cases are exemplified below:

Pronouns

The pronouns in Bhatri may be classed as the following, viz.. i) personal pronoun, ii) demonstrative pronoun, iii) relative pronoun and iv) interrogative pronoun.

Personal pronouns are inflected for (a) person, (b) numbers and (c) case, where, the pronominal bases are distinguished by a) three persons, viz.. first, second and the third. b) two numbers – singular and plural and c) six cases, viz.. nominative (- ϕ); accusative/dative (-ke); instrumental (-le, -dei); ablative (-le, -Thanu); genitive (-r, -Or, -kOr) and locative (-ne).

Personal pronoun

The personal pronouns are declined as the following:
base + number marker + case marker.
