

CHAPTER - I

Introduction, Concepts and Definitions, Jurisdictional Changes, Rural-Urban Frame Andhra Pradesh

1.1. BACKGROUND

The responsibility of the Census Organizations soon after completion of the gigantic exercise of Census operations is to release the population data on Provisional basis in usable and understandable form. The first publication of Census of India 2011 "Provisional Population Totals, Andhra Pradesh, Series-29, paper -1" was released by Director of Census Operations on 31.03.2011 for the benefit of data users. This publication consisted of Total Population - male & female, Density of population, Decadal Growth and Literates- male & female, Sex Ratio and Child Population in the age group of 0-6. The data was made available for the State as a whole and for all the constituent districts.

In continuation, this Directorate released Provisional Population Totals, Paper-2, Volume 1 of 2011, data on Rural and Urban areas, Andhra Pradesh, Series-29, up to district level on 20.07.2011. Now the Directorate of Census Operations, Andhra Pradesh is presenting the Volume 2 of Paper 2 covering the data on rural and urban areas up to mandal level.

1.2. Scope of the present Volume

Census represents the changing patterns of the society in a period of every 10 years which can be considered reasonable for drawing meaningful inferences. The Government, Planners, Academicians, Researchers, Commercial/Non-commercial Institutions curiously await the data for administrative and academic purposes. This volume attempts to make an analysis of the pattern of Provisional Population viz., its distribution & growth, Literacy, Sex Ratio, Density in both Rural and Urban areas of the State. The compilation of the data and its representation separately for rural and urban areas help in understanding the trends such as the concentration of Population in urban areas as compared to the rural areas, migration from rural to urban areas, pressure on urban infrastructure facilities, and a comparison of not only urban and rural areas of 2011 Census but also with that of 2001 Census. This volume also makes an attempt to understand the rural-urban scenario over the past five decades i.e. from 1961-2011.

Broadly this publication depicts the data in the form of tables as indicated below.

It may be recalled that in Paper -1 the basic denominators for demographic study viz., growth rate, density, sex ratio and literacy were cartographically represented where no distinction was made between the rural and urban frame of the State. However, in this publication cartographic representations are made depicting the position of the rural and urban areas separately.

1.3 ADMINISTRATIVE UNITS

1.3.1 RURAL

Revenue village is the lowest administrative unit in rural areas for presenting the census data. Coverage of constituent hamlets if any to a village was ensured while forming the Enumeration Blocks (EBs). Population of villages vary and even villages with 'Nil' population exist. Each village is segmented into small units maintaining geographical contiguity and with an average population of 500-600 or approximately 125 HHs called Enumeration Blocks (EBs). Even an Un-inhabited village is also covered under one EB for ensuring total coverage. The population figures will be presented for each village.

There are 27,800 villages which constitute the rural areas of the State. Out of these, there are three Forest Villages reported as located in Bhadrachalam Mandal of Khammam district.

After 2001 Census 3 new mandals are formed in addition to the existing 1125 in 2001 Census. These are Elgaid in Karimnagar district, Thoguta in Medak district and Rowtulapudi in East Godavari district. With these 3 new mandals, the total No. of mandals in the state increased to 1128. Of these, 29 are fully urban and 1099 are rural mandals.

1.3.4 URBAN

Ward is the basic administrative unit in urban areas for presenting census data. Enumeration Blocks are carved out as mentioned above for census taking and data summed up ward-wise for final presentation.

The definition of an urban unit adopted at 2011 Census is as follows-

- a) All places with a Municipal Corporation, Cantonment Board, Municipality, Nagar Panchayat etc.
- b) All other places which satisfy the following criteria :
 - i) A minimum population of 5000
 - ii) At least 75 percent of the male working population are engaged in non-agricultural pursuits and
 - iii) population density of at least 400 per Sq.Km.

This unit under Census Operations is called a Census Town (CT)

The criteria adopted at 2001 Census for urban areas is followed even in 2011 Census. This is to enable comparison with previous Census and analysis of urban trends in the State.

Areas notified as local bodies like municipal corporations, municipalities, Nagar Panchayats, Cantonment Boards, etc., irrespective of their demographic characteristics are statutory towns.

In Andhra Pradesh, there are 125 Statutory Towns of which 15 are Municipal Corporations (M.Corp.), 102 are Municipalities, 7 are Nagar Panchayats and 1 Cantonment Board. There are 228 Census Towns identified in 2011 Census.

1.3.6 URBAN AGGLOMERATION

The concept of Urban Agglomeration (U.A.) was first introduced in 1971 Census replacing the concept of 'town-group' adopted in the 1961 Census. This concept of urban agglomeration is continued since then and also in Census 2011.

The following are the possible different situations in which urban agglomeration is constituted.

An urban agglomeration is a continuous urban spread consisting of

- a statutory town with one or more contiguous outgrowths
- two or more adjoining towns (of which at least one is a statutory town) with their outgrowths

The total population of all the constituents put together should not be less than 20,000.

In some cases Railway Colonies, University Campuses, Port areas, Military camps etc. have come up near a city or statutory town outside its statutory limits but within the revenue limits of a village or villages contiguous to the town. Each such area by itself might not have satisfied the minimum population limit to qualify as an independent urban unit but deserves to be clubbed with the towns as continuous urban spread. A Census Town is considered as a constituent unit of the Urban Agglomeration.

The area constituting urban agglomeration may change from last Census depending upon the changing boundaries of the statutorily notified main urban units as well as the extent of the urban outgrowths.

1.3.8 OUT-GROWTHS (O.GS.)

A village or a part thereof which is immediately adjacent to a statutory town and has pronounced urban characteristics but does not qualify to be an independent town is treated as an Out Growth. The following points are kept in mind before determining outgrowths in relation to a statutory town and urban agglomeration.

- i) If there is some uninhabited area between an urbanized village or villages and the statutory limit of a town, such villages are not treated as outgrowth to constitute an urban agglomeration, as they will not form a contiguous spread with the town on account of the intervening uninhabited area.
- ii) If there is a town in proximity to a core town but not actually contiguous to it, being separated by an intervening rural area, these towns are not included into urban agglomeration. They will be considered as forming an urban agglomeration only if the intervening rural area has pronounced urban features qualifying that area to be considered as an outgrowth.
- iii) While determining the outgrowth of a town, it is ensured that it possessed the requisite urban features in terms of infrastructure and amenities. The outgrowth shall be a viable unit such as a village or a hamlet or an enumeration block and is clearly identifiable in terms of its boundaries and location.
- iv) In the case of a whole revenue village which is treated as an outgrowth of a town, its data are included under the relevant urban agglomeration, where only a part of the village is included in the urban agglomeration as an outgrowth, data relating to the O.G portion are presented under the urban agglomeration, while the data relating to the rest of the village are presented in the rural frame.

- v) While carving out enumeration blocks at the time of Census, care is taken to see that an enumeration block does not cut across the boundaries of a town and its outgrowth. In other words, such outgrowths are constituted into a separate enumeration block or blocks depending on size. These blocks are assigned serial numbers at the end of the series of the charge for easy recognition. All these blocks are shown in the charge register of the concerned town.

In Andhra Pradesh, total towns are 353 out of them 125 are Statutory Towns (STs) and 228 are Census Towns (CTs). Besides 353 towns there are 209 Out-growths. All areas identified as Municipal Corporations, Statutory Towns, Census Towns and Out-growths constitute the urban frame of the State for 2011 Census.

1.4 LOCATION CODES (For field operations)

Separate series of codes are adopted in the form of Short codes for rural and urban units during 2011 Census. The location code 28 assigned to Andhra Pradesh in 2001 Census is continued in 2011 Census also. Similarly the Location codes assigned to the districts are also continued. The location codes assigned to the Mandals in 2001 are also continued in all the districts except for some mandals in the districts of Karimnagar, Medak and East Godavari where short codes of some mandals are changed due to formation of one new mandal each in these three districts. Further the short codes for each revenue village within a mandal, for each mandal with in a district are assigned starting from the North-west, and proceeding in a serpentine manner towards South-east corner.

Each of the 27,800 villages in the state are allotted a 4 digit short code within each mandal starting from 0001. Forest Villages are given codes starting from 6001. Short codes in 2011 Census are resorted to reduce the writing work of the Enumerator and transcription errors that may arise due to lengthy nature of numbers.

The system of assigning location code numbers to urban units has also changed. A separate series of codes are developed for urban units in place of Roman numbers allotted in 2001. All the Statutory Towns in the State are assigned a separate 4 digit code starting from 7001. Similarly, all the Census Towns (CT) are given 4 digit codes starting from 8001. One specific feature regarding location codes of urban areas in 2011 Census is if the Town spreads in more than one mandal, then it is assigned as many town codes as the number of mandals in which it is spread. Eg. Bellampalle Municipality in Adilabad district is spread in 2 mandals viz., Bellampalle and Kasipet accordingly two codes are assigned. Each ward in every urban area is assigned a 4 digit number starting with 0001 within the urban unit.
