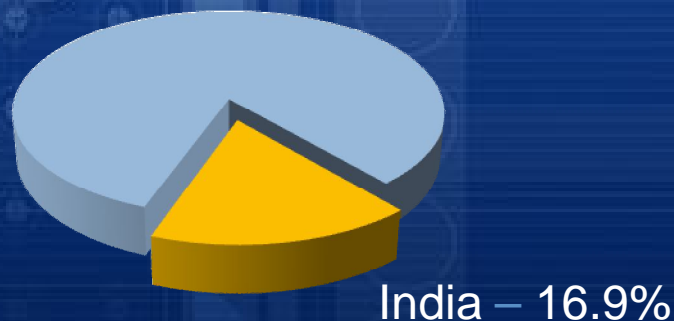

Every 6<sup>th</sup> person in the world is an Indian



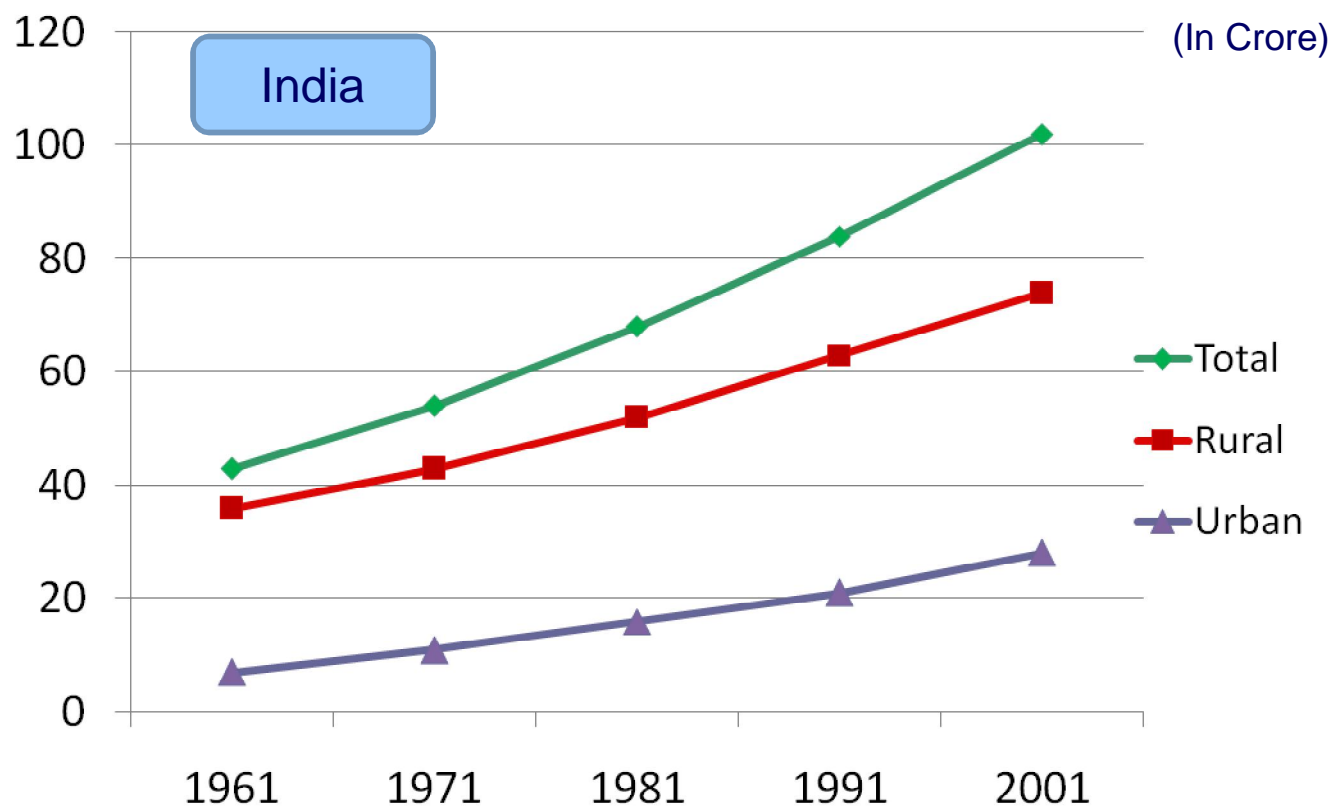
# Population of India since 1961

Population of India increased from 43.9 crore in 1961 Census to 102.8 crore in 2001 Census



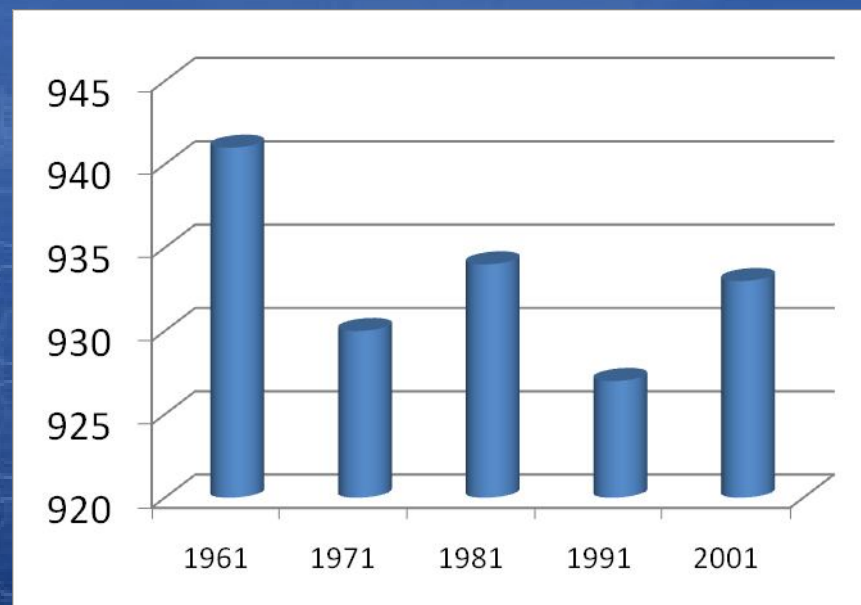
# Sex Ratio - India - 1961-2001

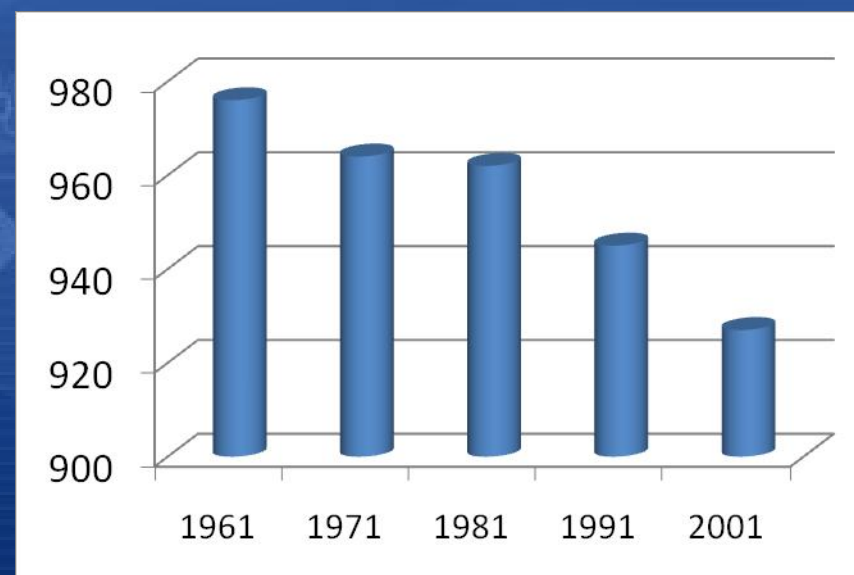

Child sex ratio saw a steep decline from 976 in 1961 to 927 in 2001 Census



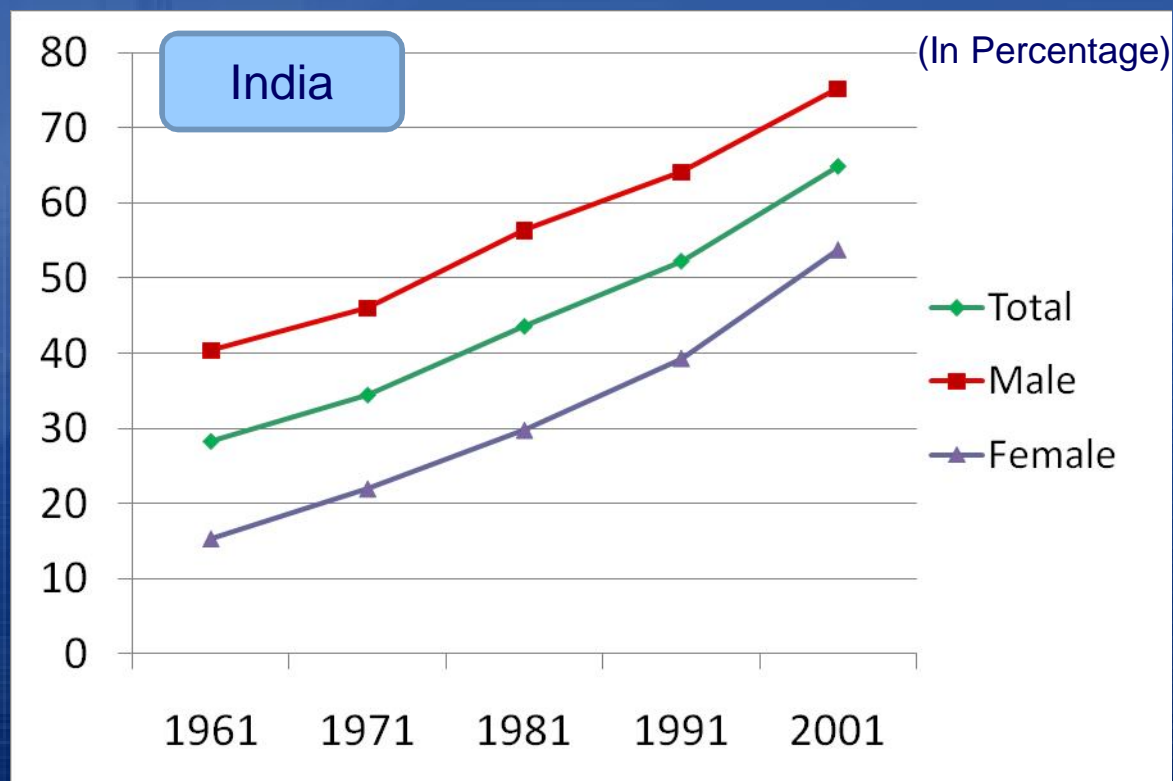
# Literacy Rates - 1961-2001 Census

- Female literacy rate increased from 15.4% in 1961 Census to 53.7% in 2001



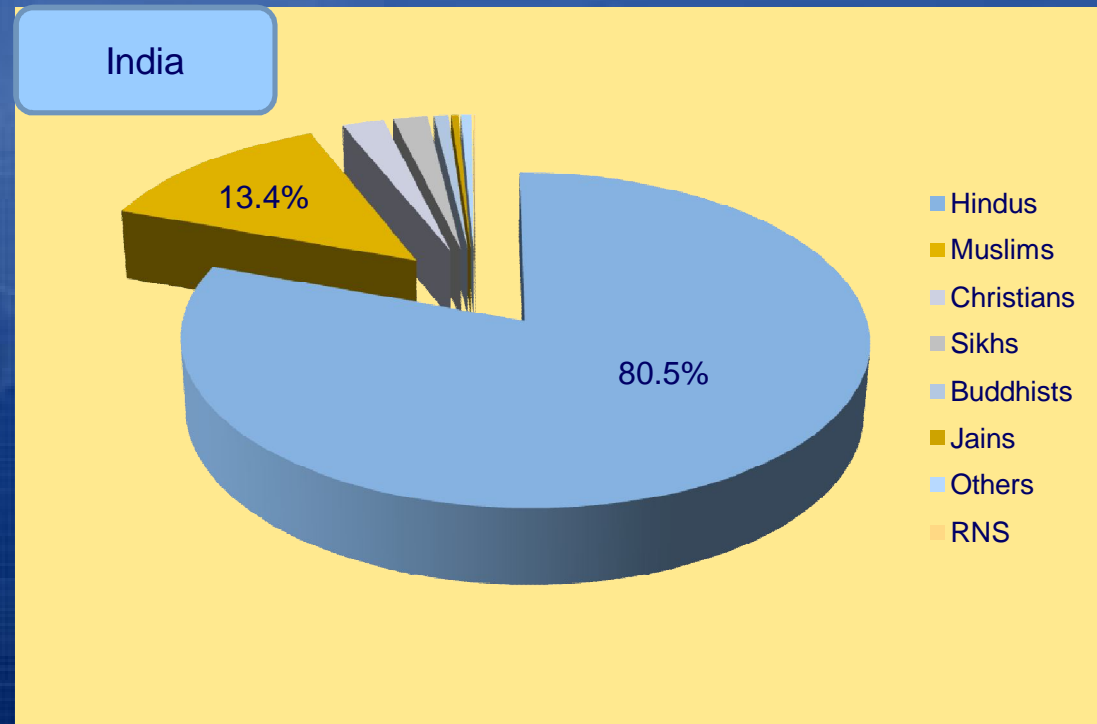
# Religion- 2001 Census

# Language- 2001 Census

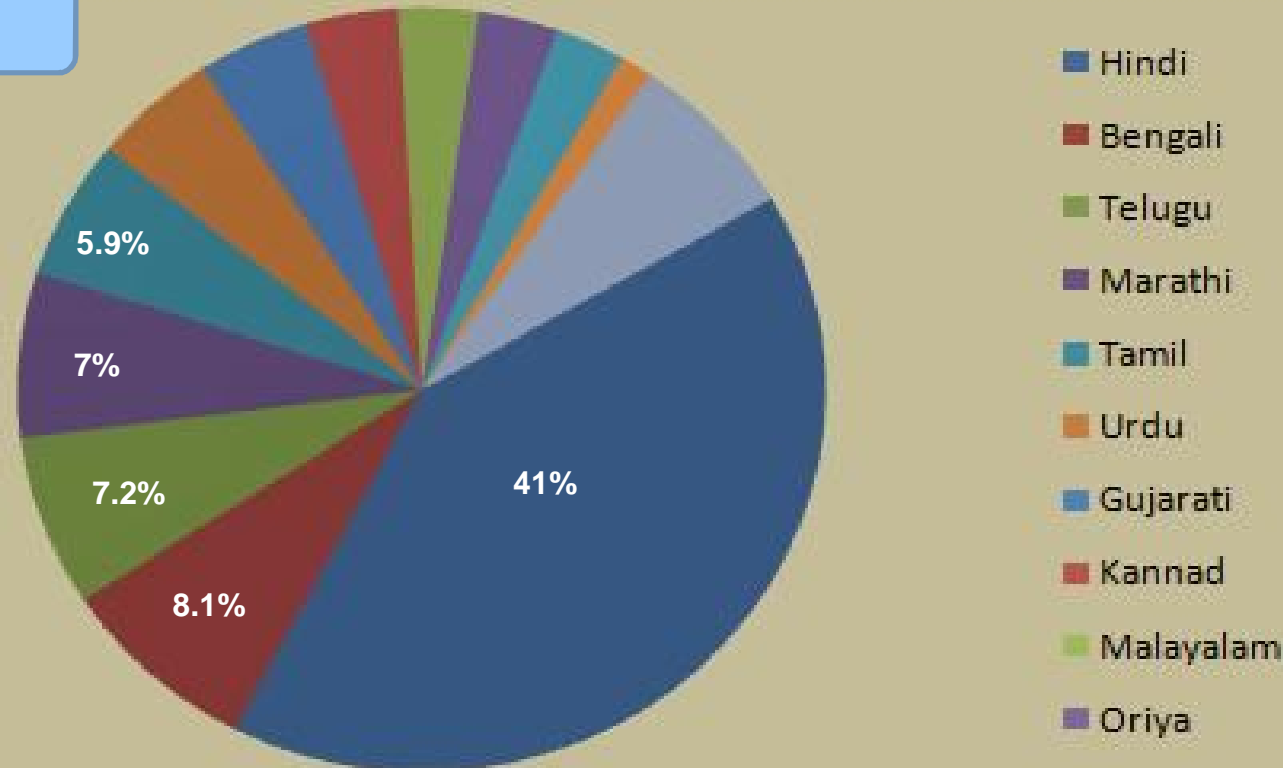

6661 Mother Tongues returned in Census 2001. Hindi has been returned as the predominant language spoken by about 41% of the population. Next four in order of number of speakers are: Bengali (8.1%), Telugu (7.2%), Marathi (7%) and Tamil (5.9%)



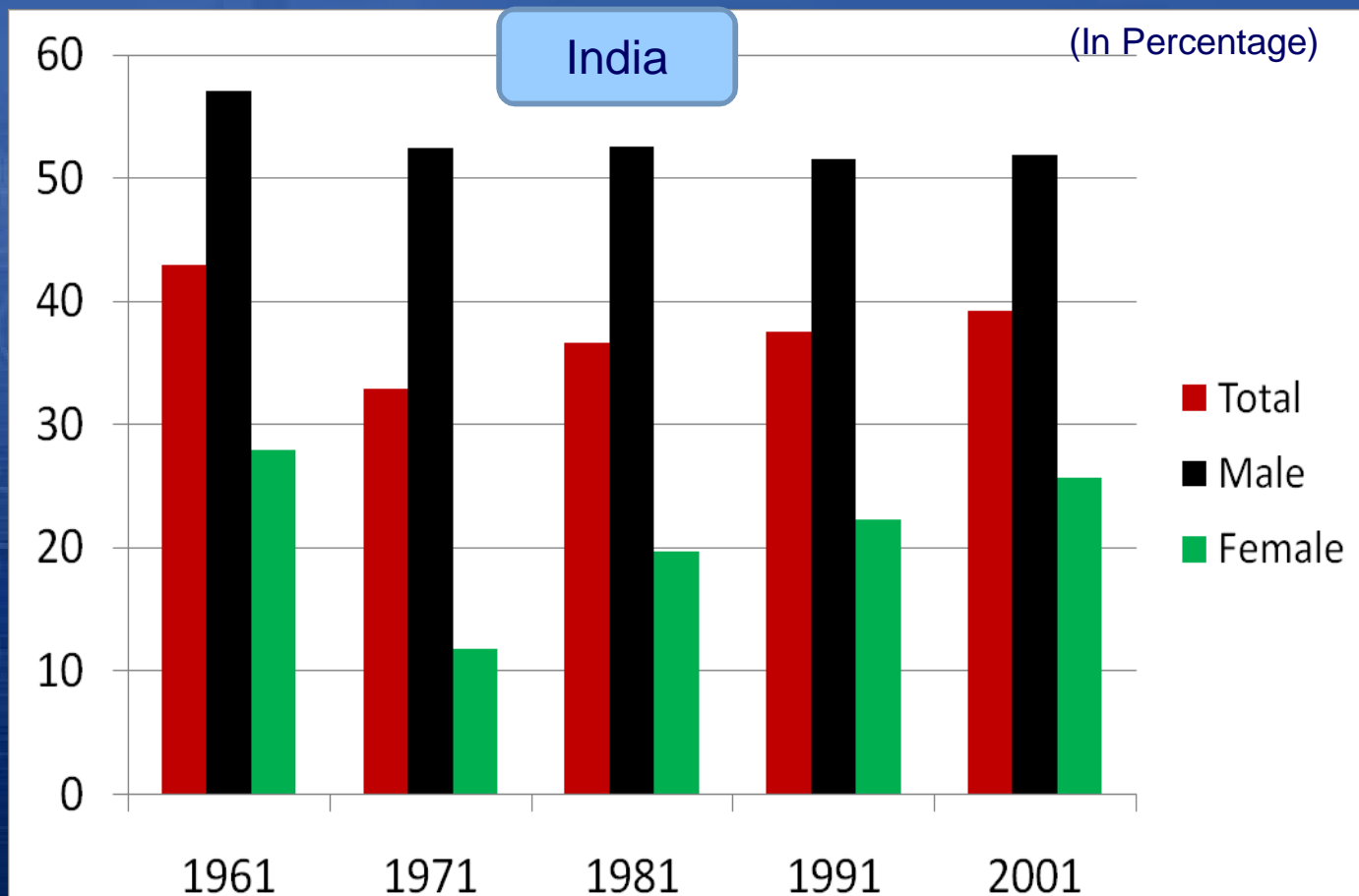
# Work Participation Rate

Work Participation Rate in India increased from 37.5% in 1991 Census to 39.1% in 2001 Census



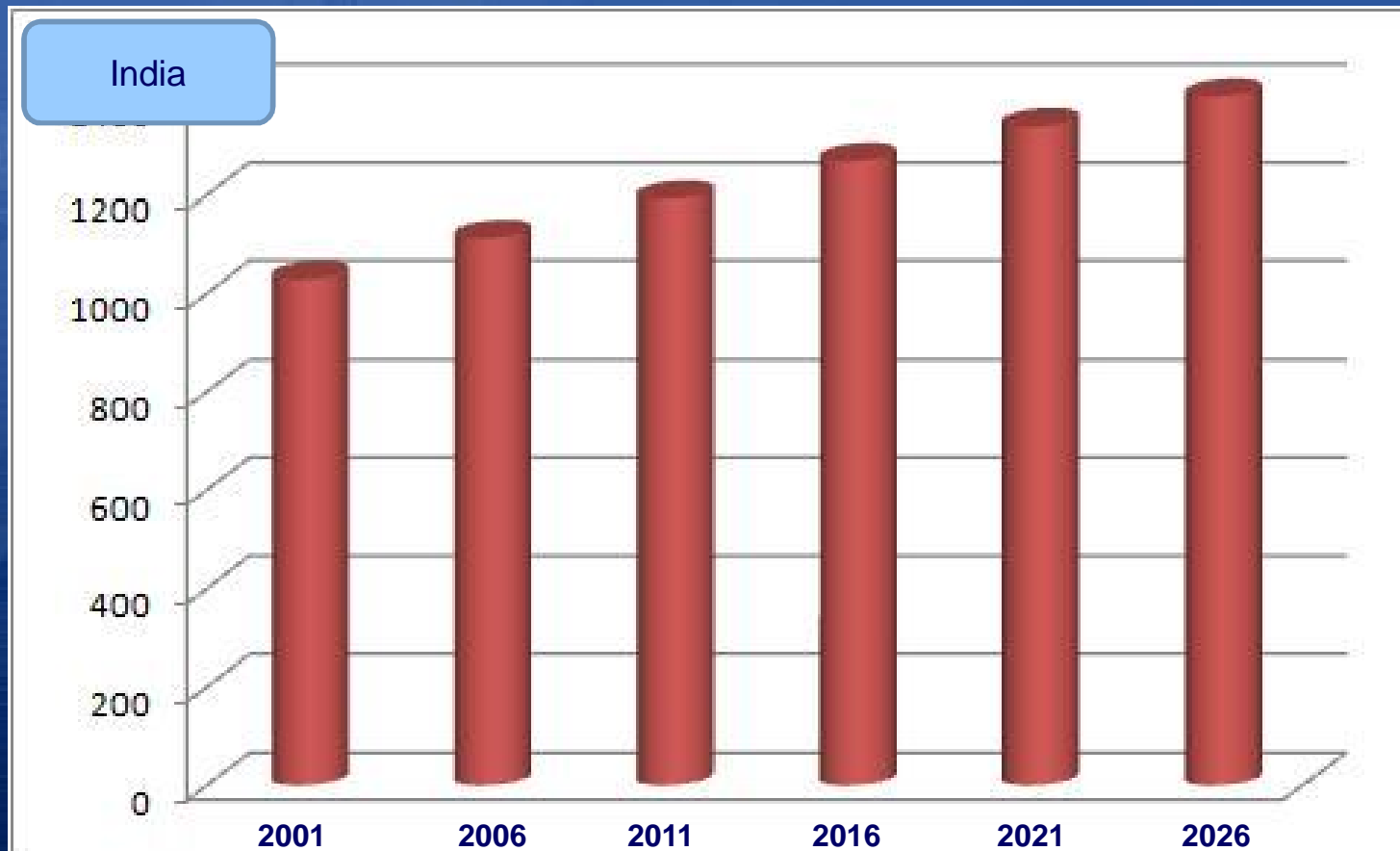
# Projected Population
