FINAL POPULATION TOTAL

The Census Commissioner, India has released the final population totals and Scheduled Caste population and Scheduled Tribe population of all states and union territories in the country as per the 2001 Census. Earlier, just after the completion of the 2001 Census in March 2001, provisional population of India was published for each state, district, sub-district and town in the country. Now after the scanning and processing of the data collected, the final population totals have been released up to village and ward in town level (see box).

The final population dataset is presented on the following indicators:

- Population by sex
- Scheduled Caste population by sex
- Scheduled Tribe population by sex

The above dataset is part of the Primary Census Abstract, which are published by the Census organisation as part of regular publication programme. A separate compilation was released in advance to meet the demand for the final population data.

PRIMARY CENSUS ABSTRACT (PCA) : 2001 CENSUS

Based on the 2001 Census the Primary Census Abstracts were released for each state and union territory in the country. This dataset provides data at state, district, sub-district, town,

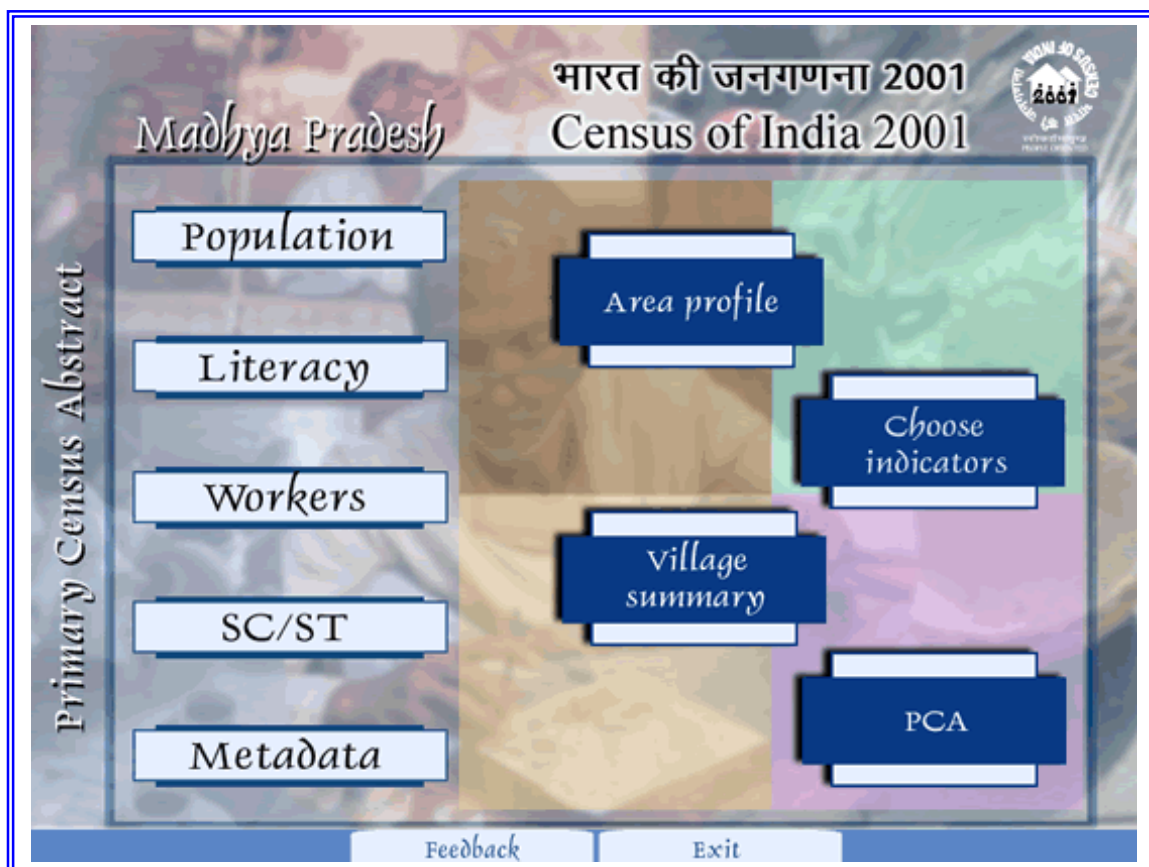
village and ward in town for each state or union territory separately. The India volume, termed as Union Primary Census Abstract, contains data at India, state and city or urban agglomeration/ town levels. This dataset is based on the final population unlike the provisional population released earlier. All census tables to be generated and published will correspond to this final population only and not the provisional population.

The Primary Census Abstract comprises of the following variables:

- Number of household
- Population
- Population in the age group 0 to 6 years
- Scheduled Caste population
- Scheduled Tribe population
- Number of literate
- Total worker
- Main worker
- Marginal worker
- Type of worker (viz. Cultivator, Agricultural labourer, household industries workers and Other worker)
- Non-worker

At present the PCA dataset is available only in CD in electronic format and regular publications in print will be released when printing process is completed.

Twelve CDs have been published on PCA data containing the entire dataset as mentioned above. Besides the CD also contain many additional features by way of value additions. A facsimile of the home page showing different sections is reproduced below:



One of the interesting sections in the CD is the 'Area Profile'. It allows a user to view the all the variables at one place as well as showing the various ratios and percentages (see below). The user may choose to view the Area Profile of the state or a district or sub-

district, town or village or ward, as the case may be. With every Area Profile, a map depicting the location of the district in a state or a sub-district in a district is shown.

HOUSING CONDITION IN TAMIL NADU

[India has a long tradition of conducting population censuses. As part of each census, house numbering and houselisting have been undertaken a few months ahead of the main census. During this exercise, besides identifying each building or structure in an area, information on use of census house, condition of census house, material of construction of roof, wall and floor, tenure status and a host of other information including data on household amenities and assets are collected. This dataset is useful in finding out the housing condition and availability of amenities and assets to households. Separate dataset are also available for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes.]

Tamil Nadu is one of the important states in south India which has shown remarkable improvement in living conditions when compared to the situation in 1991 Census.

Of the total number of 14,173,626 households netted during houselisting of the Census of India 2001 in the State, 8,295,106 households constituting 58.52% live in permanent houses (i.e., houses with wall and roof made of permanent materials). Households living in semi-permanent houses (i.e., houses in which either wall or roof is made of permanent material and other is made of temporary material) form 18.15% (2,572,029 households). About 23.31% of the households numbering 3,304,310 live in temporary houses (i.e., houses with wall and roof made of temporary material). Among them, 2,789,773 households are living in serviceable houses (i.e., where **wall is made of mud, un-burnt-brick or wood**) and the remaining 514,537 households in non-serviceable houses (i.e., where wall is made of grass, thatch, bamboo etc., plastic or polythene). In rural Tamil Nadu, 47.30% of households live in permanent houses, 20.21% in semi-permanent houses and 32.48% in temporary houses (28.39% in serviceable and 4.10% in non-serviceable). About 74.27% of the urban households in the State are housed in permanent structures. Households living in semi-permanent houses constitute 15.26% of urban households. Households living in temporary houses form 10.45% of which 7.47% are in serviceable and 2.98% in non-serviceable houses.

In 1991, of the 12,342,715 total households in the State, 5,618,265 households constituting 45.52% were in permanent houses, 2,310,125 households (18.72%) in semi-permanent houses and 4,414,325 households (35.76%) in temporary houses. Among the
