TENDER CALL NOTICE No.D-13012/03/2011-GS DATED 02.09.2011

In view of low offers received in response to this office Tender Call Notice No.D-13012/03/2011-GS Dated 25.07.2011, the quotations received have been cancelled by the Competent Authority. Sealed tenders are, therefore, re-invited from reputed firms / contractors for purchase of obsolete/unserviceable store items lying in ORGI, (HQ), 2/A, Man Singh Road New Delhi. The list of items proposed to be disposed off is enclosed.

The interested parties may submit their tenders in sealed covers at 2/A Mansingh Road, New Delhi along with an earnest money of Rs.5000/- (Rupees five thousand only) in the form of Demand Draft / Pay order from any nationalized bank drawn in favour of the **Registrar General, India, New Delhi** latest by 3 P.M. of dated 13.09.2011. The tender shall be opened on the same day at 3.30 P.M. in presence of tenderers or their authorized representatives, if any. The quotations received after stipulated date and time shall not be entertained. The quotations received without earnest money in the form of demand draft / pay order shall be summarily rejected without assigning any reason.

Other terms and conditions are given below:

- (1) Those firms, who had participated earlier, need not send fresh EMD of Rs.5,000/- They may however, revise their quoted purchase value, against their earlier quotations.
 - (2) Obsolete / unserviceable store items may be inspected on any working day during working hours (4 PM to 6 PM) and tenderers can meet the building incharge at the Registrar General, India's, 2/A, Man Singh Road New Delhi.
 - (3) The firm offering highest purchase value for all the items will be declared as successful for the tender.
 - (4) Full payment after adjustment of EMD will have to be made by the successful tenderer(s) within two working days in the form of Demand Draft / Pay order drawn in favour of the **Registrar General, India, New Delhi** from the offer date and arrange to lift the obsolete/unserviceable store items from this office within next two days failing which the offer will stand cancelled and earnest money would be forfeited.
 - (5) In case of the failure of the highest bidder to lift the items as per the conditions laid down at (4) above opportunity shall be given to the next bidders with the same conditions.
 - (6) EMD of the unsuccessful bidders shall be returned within 30 days.
