

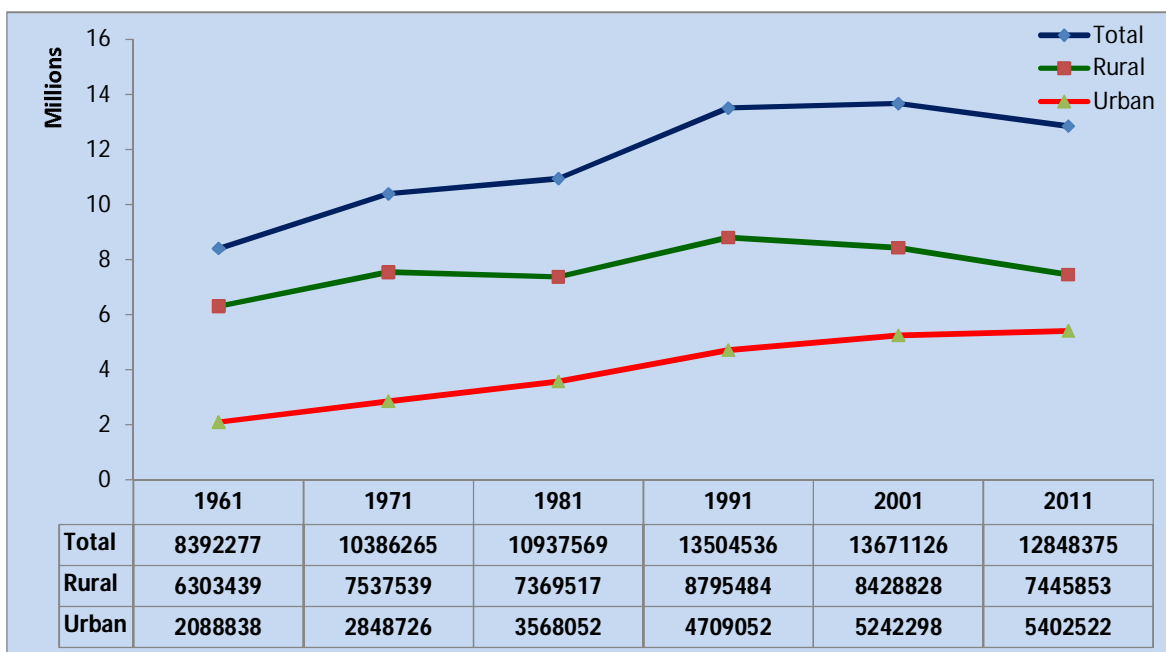

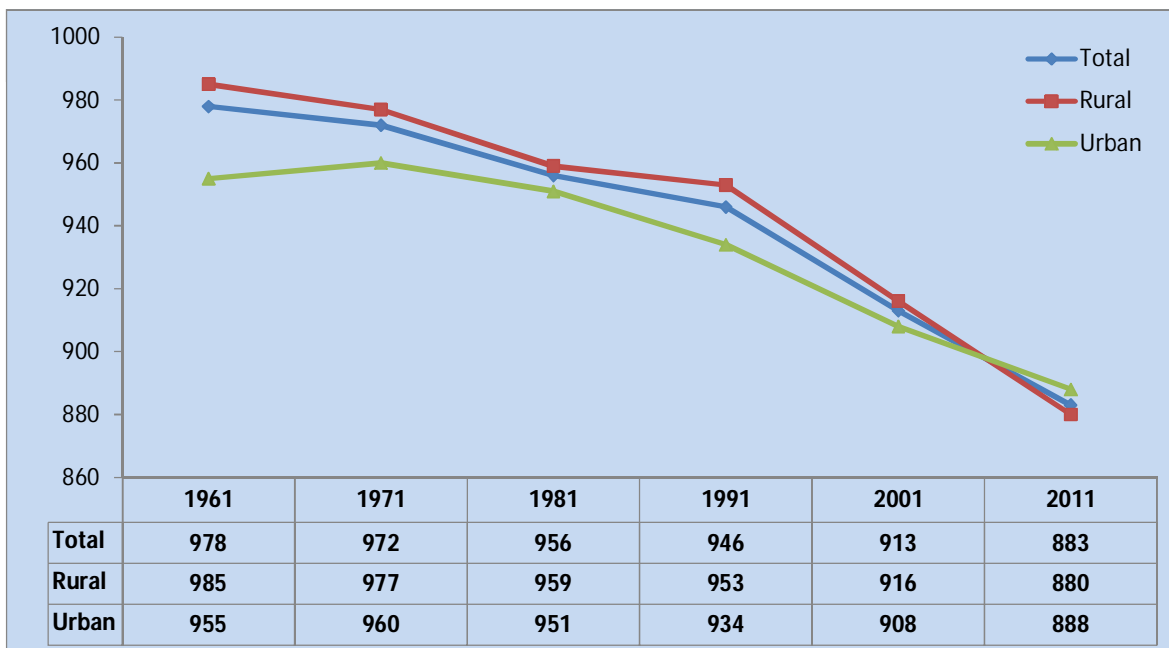

Child Sex Ratio by Residence, Maharashtra (1961-2011)



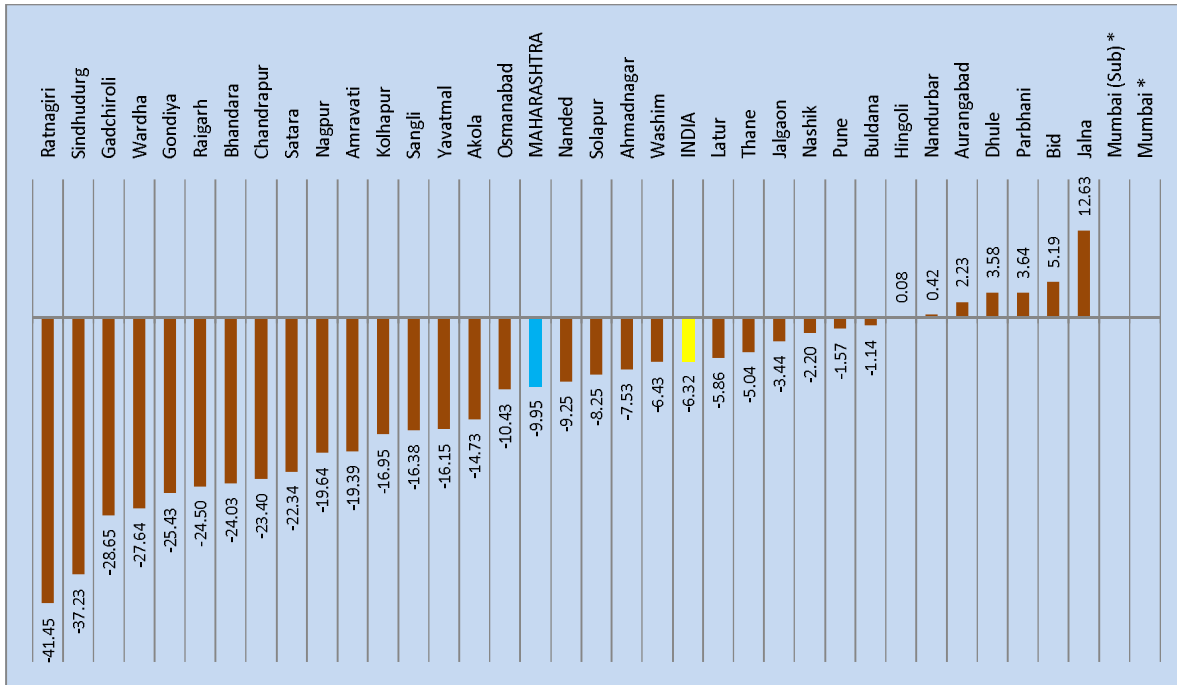

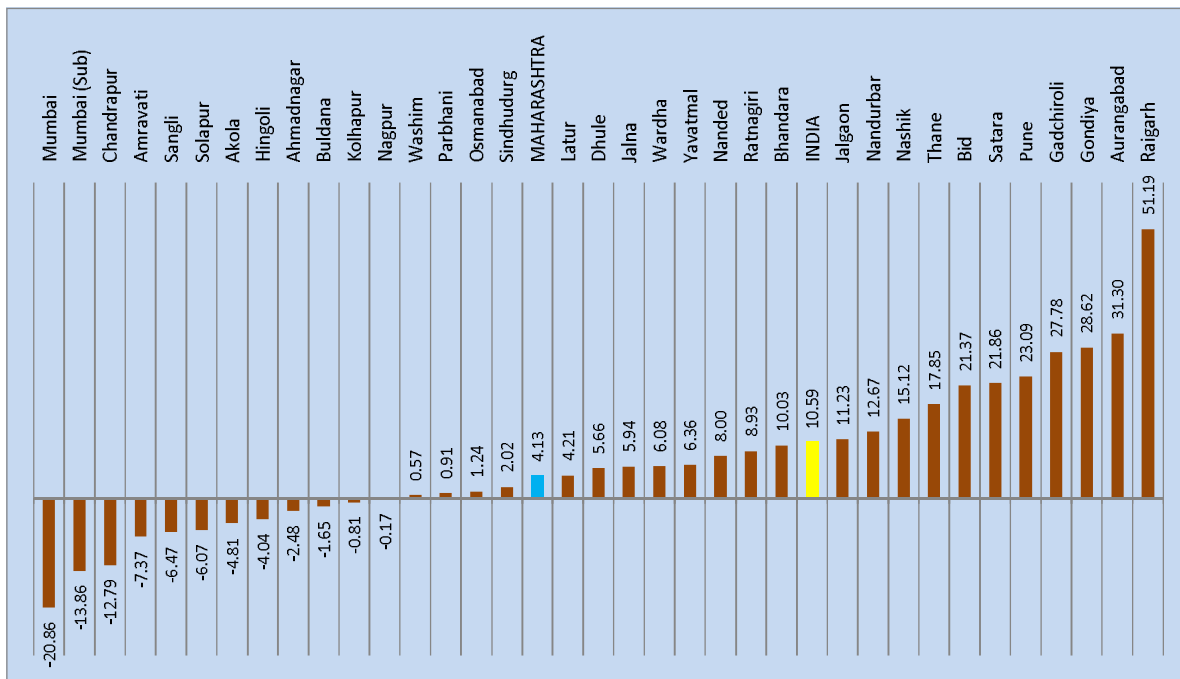

Decadal growth of child population Maharashtra and Districts (2001-2011) Urban (Males)



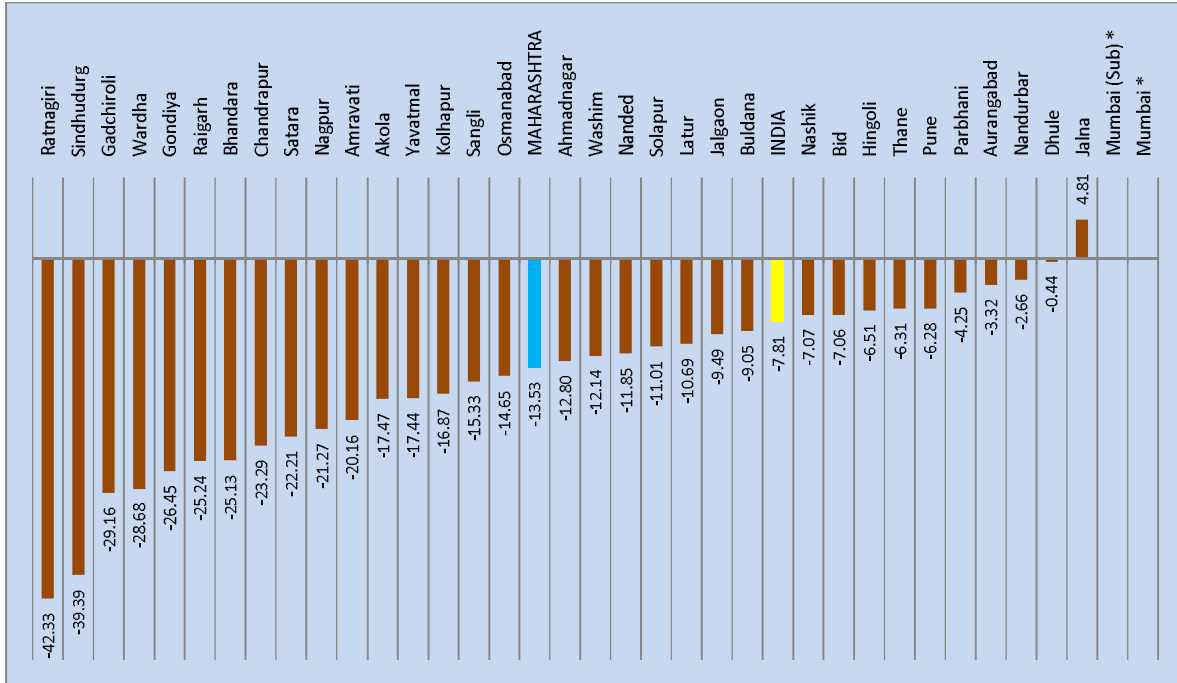

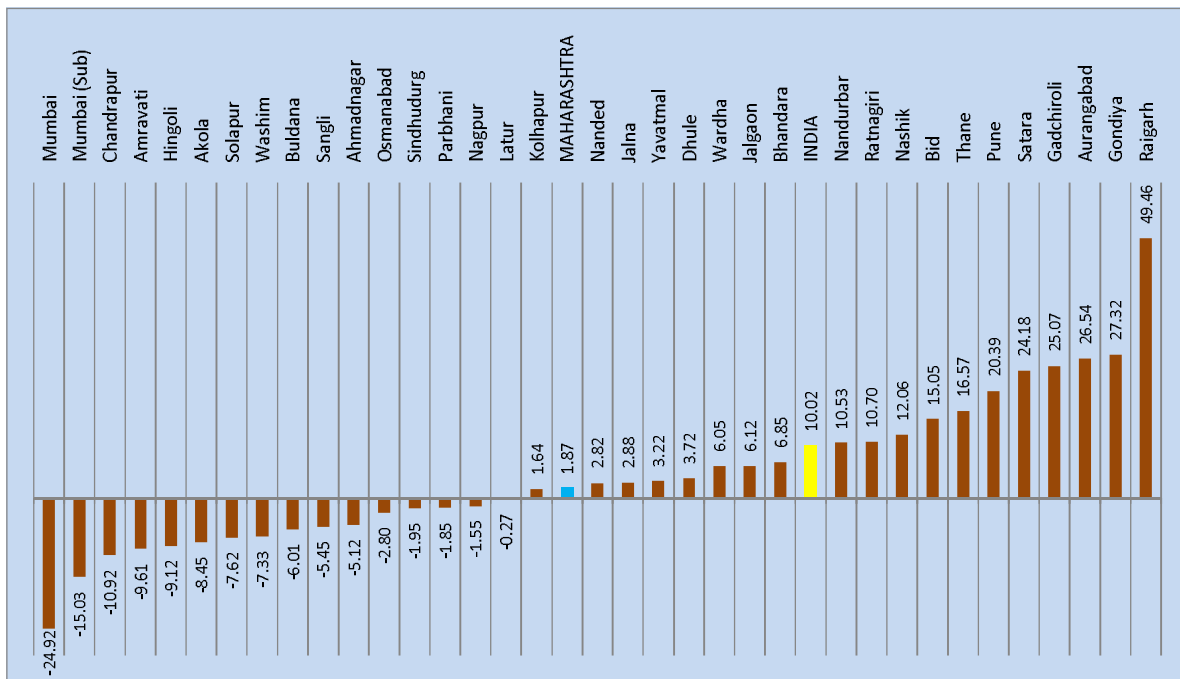

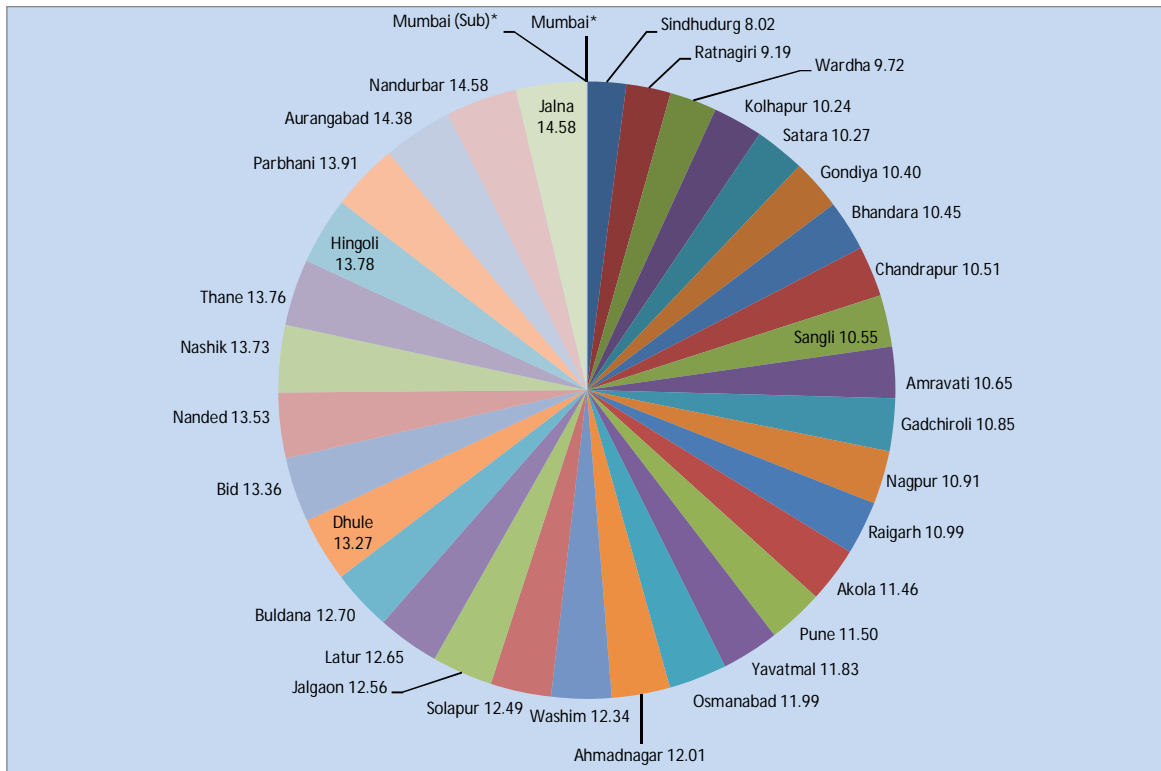

Percentage share of child population, Maharashtra (2011)

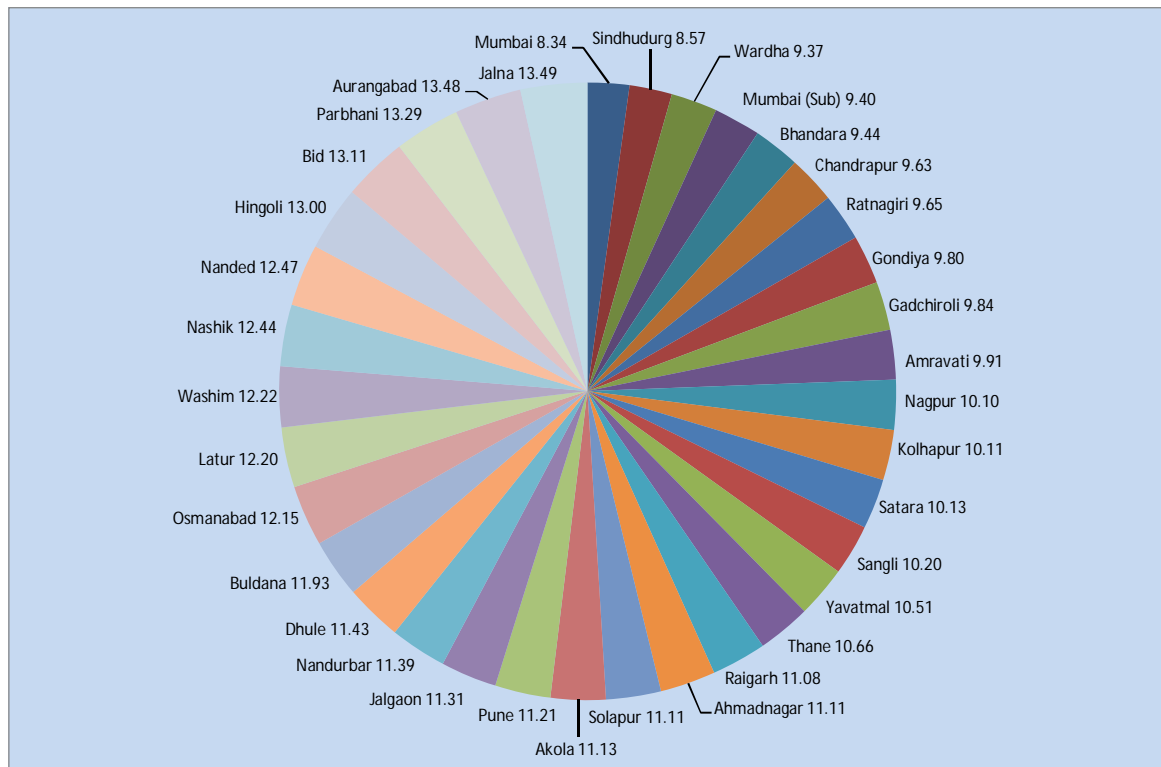

Urban



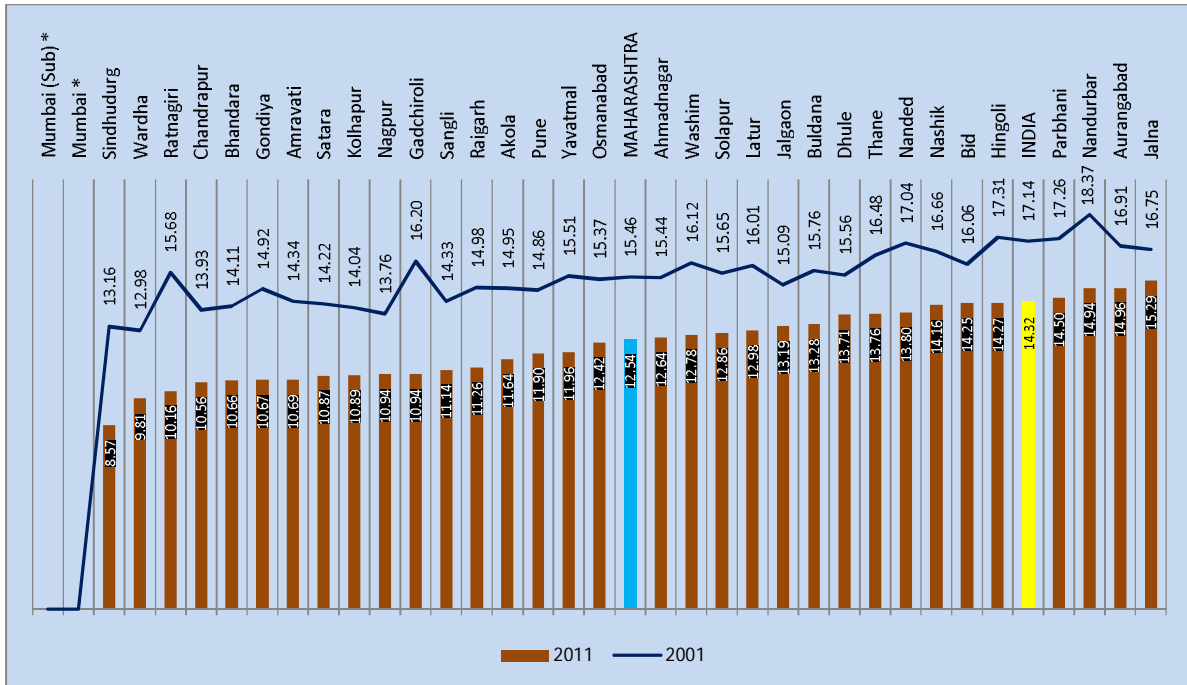

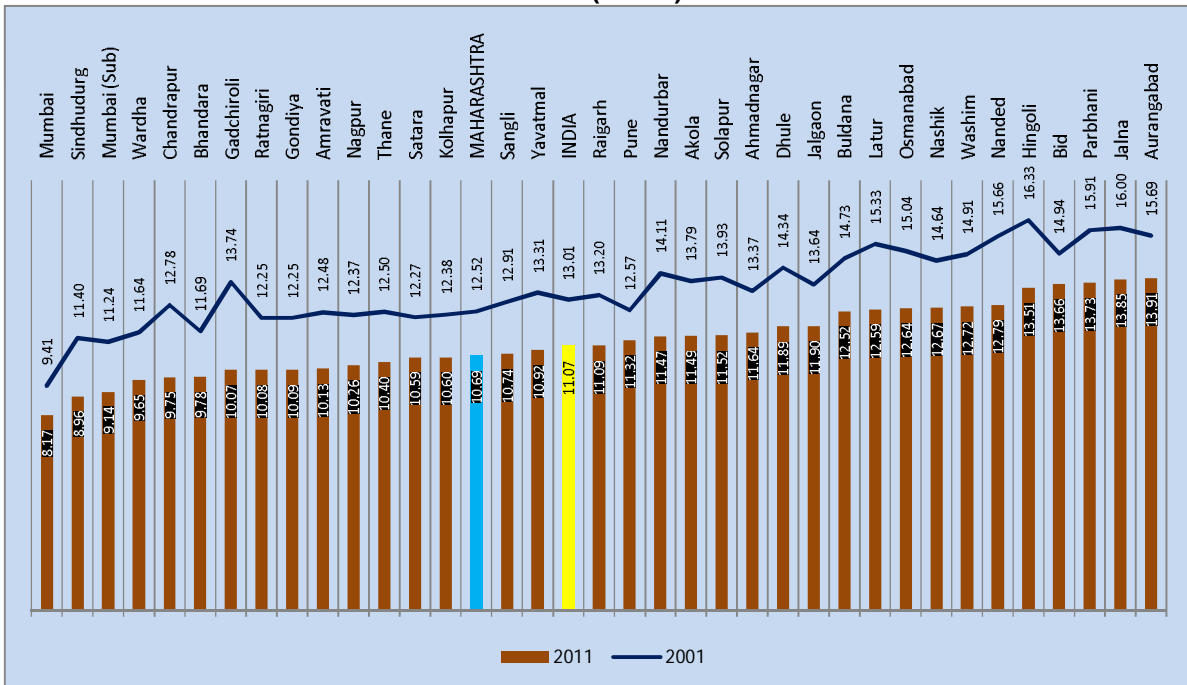

Urban (Males)



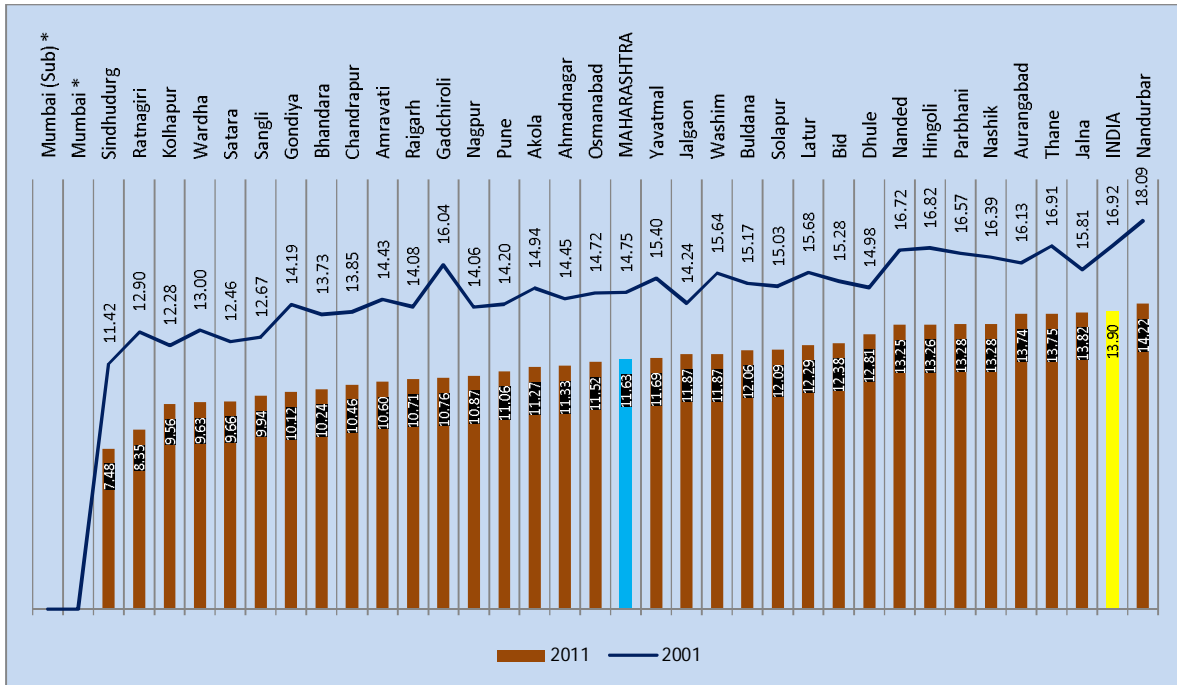

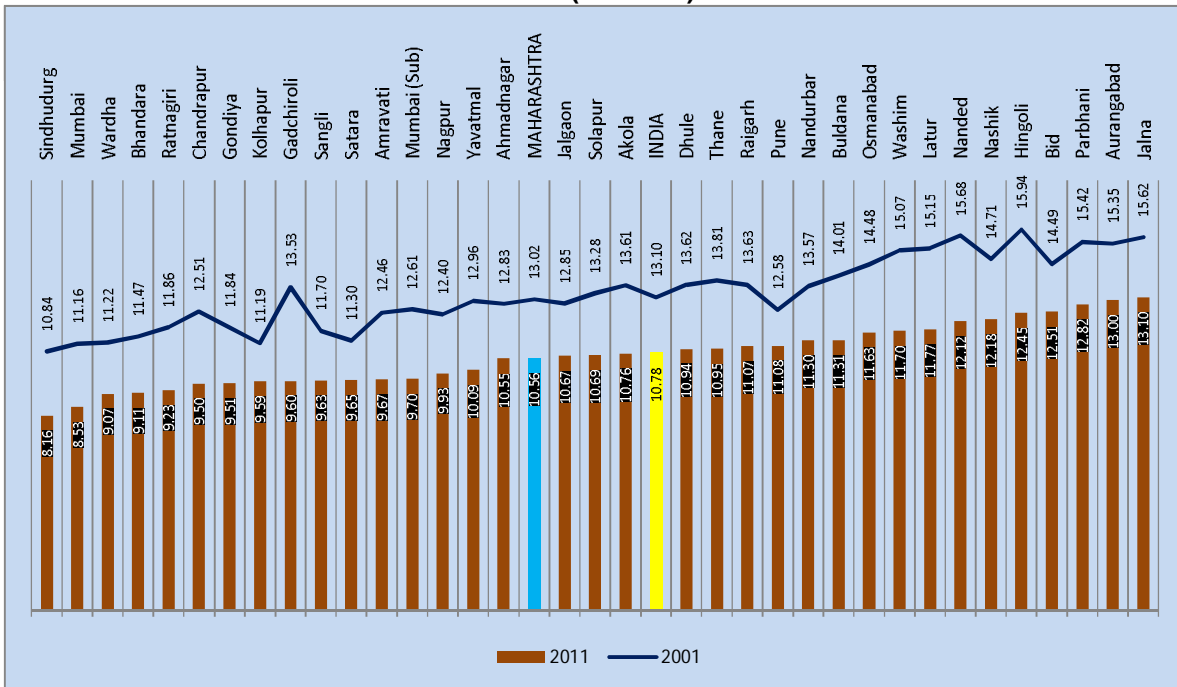

Percentage of child population by residence, Maharashtra and Districts (2001-2011) Urban (Females)



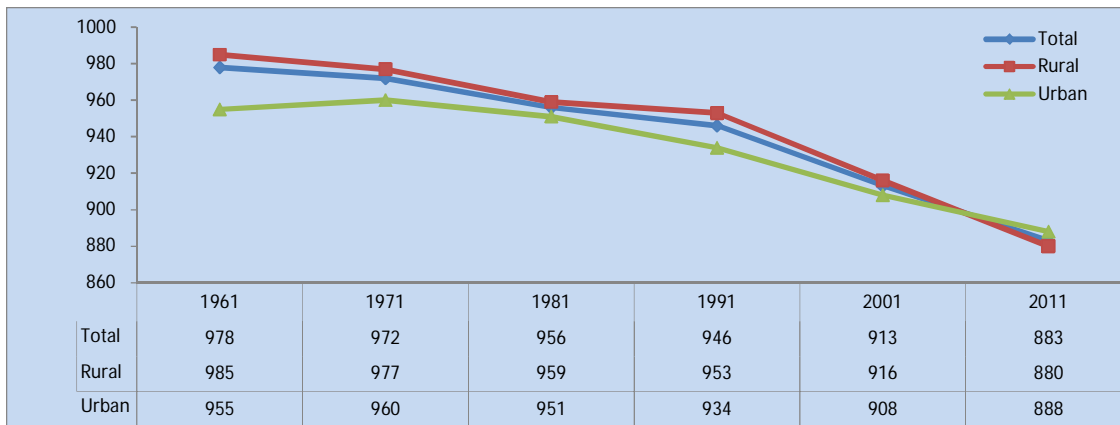

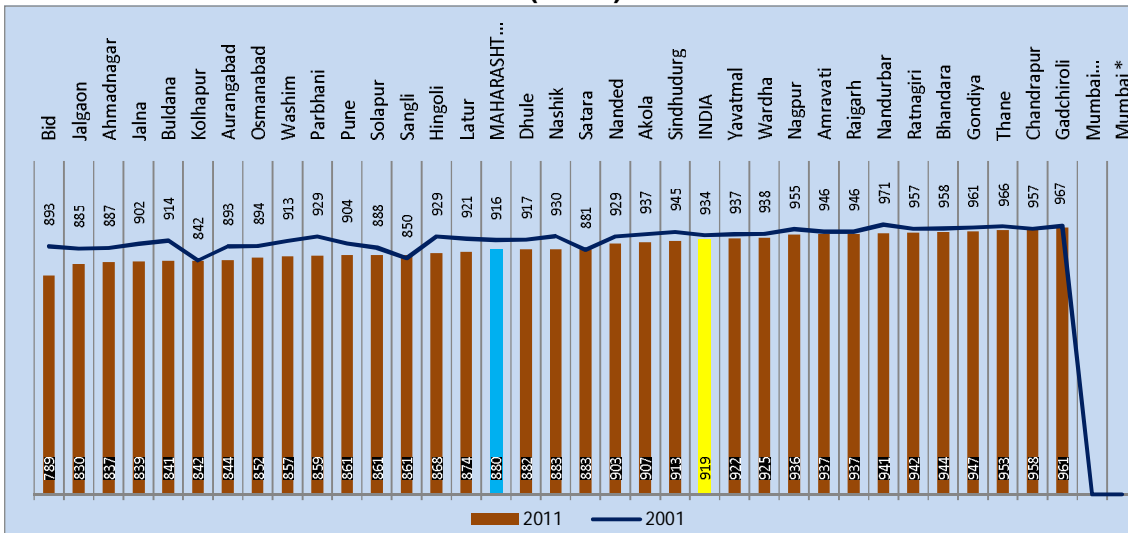
